



Integrative Shared Medical Appointments

The next 5-week series of integrative shared medical appointments starts Thursday Feb 1, meeting every Thursday in Feb from 2 – 4 PM. The spring series is scheduled to begin May 1 and will be held every Wednesday in May from 5:30 to 7:30 PM. Shared integrative medical appointments are held in the ACH teaching kitchen, are co-facilitated by Dr. Alyssa Finn and Chef Ben Ramsdell, are limited to 6-8 patients, and focus on lifestyle changes. Content includes nutrition education, label-reading, menu planning, mindfulness and stress reduction, and Mediterranean and plantbased cooking and eating. The group cooks and eats together at each session. Patients may attend for help with a number of conditions, such as high blood pressure, diabetes, high cholesterol, obesity, anxiety, depression, loneliness, or chronic pain; sessions are billed as medical appointments. Please task Dr. Alyssa Finn with the names of any interested patients, and Dr. Finn will reach out to facilitate registration.

RHEDI Certification Awarded

We are thrilled to announce that our family medicine residency is now officially a RHEDI certified program! This status change honors the comprehensive sexual and reproductive healthcare (SRH) education, including abortion care training, which we offer to residents and medical students. As a RHEDI program, we will have increased access to resources, support for increasing SRH procedural training for residents, and the boost in recruitment that comes with national visibility. Honduras Brigade 2024

MDFMR has partnered with Shoulder to Shoulder to deliver primary care in rural Honduras annually since 2015 (excepting two COVID years). Shoulder to Shoulder is a North American-based NGO which contracts with the government of Honduras to provide long-term, sustainable care in the state of Intibucá in the southwest of the country. Shoulder to Shoulder coordinates the brigade, providing lodging, meals, transportation, and support personnel.
